Summer holiday club

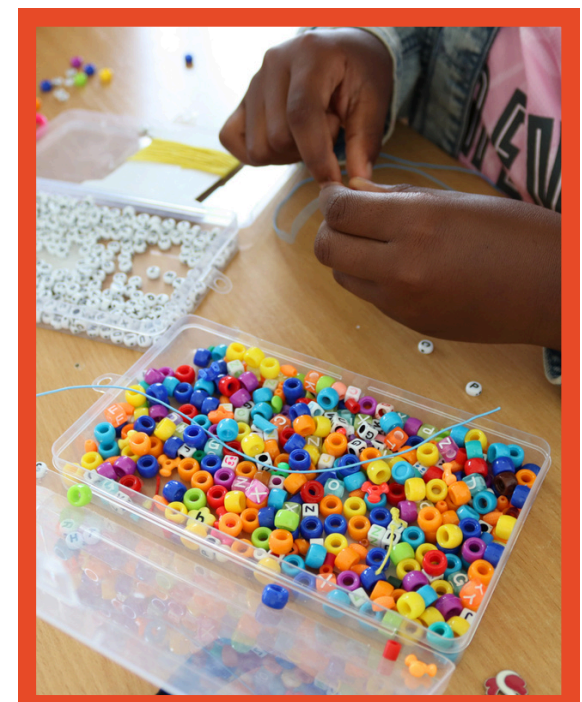
97 children aged 5-16 joined us during the summer holidays!
